BRITE N PLEASING confidently attended the pace to the quarter pole, responded quickly when urged and pulled off. VICTOR THE VICTOR came four wide through the first turn, remained close, bid three wide in the final turn and closed evenly to be clearly second best. DANZONETTE bid three wide through the second turn, had little response in the stretch but held the show easily. ACE IN SPADES saved ground throughout and did not rally. MOHEGAN CHIEF broke quickest, set all the fractions until turning for home and was steadied slightly near the furlong in tight quarters while tiring. SUNSET KID off a step slow and was never a factor. MARINE MIKE showed brief speed, dropped back rapidly, was eased through the stretch and then walked off.
