HE'S THE DEVIL chased the leaders to the turn, rallied two wide then shifted to the three path nearing the quarter pole, raced to the front in mid stretch and pushed clear late. LUCKY THIRTEEN attended the pace outside of SCOTT'S POPPY to the stretch, could not stall the winner in mid stretch but had enough left to save second. WEEKEND TIGER chased the pace alongside the winner early, was outrun by that one to the turn then fanned four wide to the stretch but failed to seriously menace in the drive. SCOTT'S POPPY had good speed, dueled inside of LUCKY THIRTEEN to the stretch but weakened through the lane. BOLD STRIDER had no speed, was two wide to the stretch then failed to threaten. CODE AMOUR was outrun to the turn, also raced two deep to the stretch but did not rally. WHITE MARK tracked the leaders to the turn, got forced out to the five path mid turn then gave way through the drive. MOUNTAIN WARRIOR also tracked the pace to the turn then saved ground to the stretch but gave out in the drive. BIG ED HILL showed little.
