VOTE was loaded last in the six hole then broke alertly and went right to the front, set all the pace to the stretch, responded to edge clear to mid stretch then held under steady pressure. FUNNY PAPERS settled mid pack to the second turn, commenced to rally leaving the three eighths, shifted three wide then angled out into the stretch and closed resolutely but was too late. SPEED ROUSER prompted the pace for six furlongs from the two path, was outrun by the winner to mid stretch and failed to rally late. FIGHTING CITY HALL had no speed, advanced inside on the second turn but went evenly through the drive. TWO TRAILS broke a bit slow, had no speed, was two wide to the stretch and picked off rivals in the lane. LIKE A TIGER tracked the pace three wide to the second turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch but failed to mount a rally late. R FAT MAN settled three wide to the half, was asked for speed while still three deep on the second turn but came up empty in the late stages. SUFFOLK PUNCH was four wide to the backstretch and settled, tried to respond to pressure on the second turn but was again caught four deep and was outrun through the stretch. HIGH LODGE pressed the pace from the rail to the second turn then gave out. SEVENGOLDNMISSILES had no speed, was not a factor then bled, was pulled up after the race and vanned off.
