Footnotes

ELDORADO PRADO raced up three wide into the first turn to gain a good striking position then raced unhurried to the second turn, quickly circled rivals four wide to the stretch to gain command at the furlong pole, briefly edged clear but was all out to last. ZAPEYE raced unhurried early from off the rail, offered his bid from the inside into the stretch and finished steadily. TRICE UP settled from the rail, raced two wide on the second turn, angled out for the drive and came on. ONE LUCKY GUY lagged early from the rail, remained inside on the second turn to rally into the stretch then flattened out late. FLYOVERFAST was not asked for speed early and was three wide to the backstretch, then tried to circle rivals six wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. CALL HIM PADDY stalked the pace from the inside, had a bid into the lane but lost his punch. GABBRO GLITZ settled early, was forced five wide on the second turn and did not rally. UNUSUAL TALENT stalked the leaders three wide to the stretch and suddenly slipped back but finished evenly in the final furlong. SOUTH FORTY set the pace from the inside to the stretch and gave way. MONSAJEM MIMESIS prompted the pace two wide for six furlongs and had little left.
