DISTANT CHARM was settled to the half, advanced inside to get into contention on the second turn, shifted out and rallied two wide into the stretch, got to terms in mid stretch then drove away late. HOLIDAY EVENT was well placed off the leaders to the half, launched a bid and came three wide on the second turn, dueled for the lead to mid stretch, could not stall the winner but dug in late to save second. THREE TIMES A LADY (NZ) had no speed and settled towards the rear, commenced to rally into the second turn while outside horses, got fanned five wide into the stretch then finished willingly to the line. FANTASTIC CAREER was unhurried to the half, started to rally and was forced four wide to the stretch and also made up ground belatedly. HIGHLY QUICK was a pace factor outside of ALL FLAGS FLYING to the half, moved up to get alongside and dueled that one into the stretch, remained a factor to mid stretch then weakened. ALL FLAGS FLYING had good speed and set a pressured pace to the half, dueled HIGHLY QUICK to the stretch then tired in the drive. ELEGANZA stalked the pace three wide to the second turn then came up empty.
