CIMMARON KID was unhurried to the half, bid four wide on the second turn, rallied into the stretch, dueled to deep stretch then inched clear despite not switching leads. TIGER CAT trailed to the second turn, bid three then four wide to the stretch then finished steadily in the final furlong but could not catch the winner. LAST DRAW never far back for a half, was two wide on the second turn but was boxed in and had to wait for room, got past a tiring LAMA CHANT and angled to the rail into the stretch, rallied to loom boldly a furlong out but was tiring late. SOUND'O GLORY contested the pace two wide for six furlongs but tired through the stretch. DRAW TWO BUCK stalked the pace for a half, offered his best bid three wide on the second turn, dueled into the stretch but was also giving way in the last eighth. LAMA CHANT attended the pace inside rivals for five furlongs, gave out into the stretch then stopped in the drive, was eased but walked off.
