SHE SPIRIT DI SU (IRE) broke alertly then was permitted to slip back just off the pace and raced under patient handling to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch, rallied to the lead a furlong out and edged clear driving. LIGHT UP THE SKY stalked three wide throughout, moved in front of the winner into the second turn, took command nearing the stretch but could not hold the winner. MS PIANIST lagged early from well off the rail, was forced to rally four wide on the second turn, loomed a bold factor once in the stretch but lost her punch. CAL BAYERS was void of early speed, was fanned five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. SUKARA was well placed from off the rail to the second turn and came up empty. SWEET NOTHINGS settled early from the rail and raced unhurried to the second turn, angled three wide at the three eighths pole, offered a minor rally into the stretch then faded late. GOOD MANGO set the pace from the inside for six furlongs and gave out. YOUTHEPRIZEANDI saved ground to no avail.
