Footnotes

CARDIFFBYTHESEA broke a bit slow but was quickly in stride and gained command from the inside in the opening stages, set all of the pace and responded when challenged by LIVE SUNDAYS and held that one at bay driving. LIVE SUNDAYS prompted the winner two wide throughout but could make no impact. COST OF FREEDOM was never too far back while four wide early, eased to the three path on the turn but failed to launch a closing rally. INDIAN WINTER settled early, saved ground and did not respond. PIANA MAN lacked early speed, steadied behind INDIAN WINTER entering the lane, then came on too late. REAGAN REPUBLICAN lagged from the outset, tried to move three wide on the turn but came up empty. HE'S SO STYLISH prompted the winner three wide early and faded.
