TWO TURNS was unhurried to the half, rallied when roused into the second turn, got fanned out four wide to the stretch, pushed to the front leaving the furlong grounds then held driving. KEYFARGO set the pace under pressure to the second turn, was overtaken but continued on willingly inside to the stretch then responded but was outfinished. GULF WING was under restraint in traffic to the first turn, raced between rivals to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch then eased out for room and finished willingly. SAVOY stalked the leaders to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch, stayed on to deep stretch but was outfinished late. TIGER ON THE PROWL was settled to the half, saved ground on the second turn then eased out in the drive and had a mild late rally. ACTION JACK was hurried early after breaking a bit tardy but was caught out four deep to the backstretch, stalked to the half, made his bid nearing the second turn and moved to the front, led to mid stretch but tired in the final furlong. MISSILE SMOKING pressed the pace to the backstretch then dropped back, saved ground on the second turn but failed to mount a serious late response. BOUNTYFUL BAR had no speed, was three wide throughout and finished evenly. IRON ROOSTER had no speed, chased to the second turn but gave out in the drive.
