**Footnotes**

DON'T REITERATE broke in stride and dueled inside FLYING SUANCES to mid turn, drew well clear in the stretch but shortened stride late held by a rapidly diminishing neck. MISS TRIPLE PLAY broke on top but stumbled sharply and quickly fell back, commenced her bid angling three wide on the turn then found a late burst nearing the wire and nearly got up. TO THE BATCAVE lagged to the turn, was fanned four wide while rallying into the stretch and closed too late. MAC TOO settled early, raced just off the rail on the turn and closed a minor gap late. FLYING SUANCES prompted the winner from the outside to the stretch and weakened. A LITTLE POLISH stalked from the rail to the turn and came up empty.
