IOTABGRAY was always within striking distance, rallied two wide on the second turn, pushed to the front a furlong out and held under steady urging. QUOTATION saved ground to the backstretch and settled, bid three wide on the second turn then closed steadily in the drive but could not catch the winner. SANGER SILVER prompted the pace to three wide to the half, offered a bold bid four wide to loom menacingly on the second turn but lost his punch in the drive. MADERIA had no speed, bid three wide on the second turn, angled inward in mid stretch but could not make an impact. REALLY SURPRISED was allowed to settle for a half mile, commenced a bid three wide into the second turn, got forced out six wide to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ROYALLY SMART was four wide to the backstretch, settled to the half, rallied boldly outside of SANGER SILVER and five wide on the second turn to also loom a threat to the stretch but faded through the lane. ATIZ was hustled and dueled from the rail for six furlongs, responded to the stretch but tired thereafter. BOLD MEETING broke a step slow and was not a factor. I NEVER LISTEN showed good speed but bore out six wide on the first turn, attended the pace for six furlongs then gave out. OPERA JIM was a pace factor for a half mile then stopped.
