Footnotes

BELS DREAM CASTLE was unhurried for five furlongs while saving ground, continued inside and was cleverly ridden on the second turn, responded on the second turn, moved up to take command inside the furlong grounds and held under steady urging. INTRIGUING VISION was allowed to settle to the second turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch, was bumped hard by HARD HEARTED LADY once straightened but recovered quickly and finished willingly to the line. GOTNACEUPERSLEEVE set all the pace to the stretch, responded to pressure to mid stretch then could not stall the top two. HARD HEARTED LADY tracked the pace to the half, bid three wide and between rivals on the second turn, angled out in upper stretch and bumped the runnerup then responded to urging while racing a bit green and was brushed by COLLATING LADY late. COLLATING LADY was four wide to the backstretch, stalked the pace to the second turn, responded three wide to the stretch, had the rider drop his whip a furlong out then drifted late while tiring and brushed HARD HEARTED LADY. QUIET ADVICE pressed the pace for six furlongs, also responded to the stretch then flattened out late. RUBY SLIPPERS had no speed, raced off the rail to the stretch but failed to mount the needed response. FANCY READER also had no speed, was fanned out five wide on the second turn and did not threaten. GRASP was rank and hard to place to the backstretch, continued to race uncomfortably inside rivals to the second turn then gave way. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run involving INTRIGUING VISION, HARD HEARTED LADY and COLLATING LADY but failed to alter the original results.
