Footnotes

PFENNING raced unhurried to the half, bid three wide on the second turn, was boxed behind HOT SCRAMBLE into the stretch, waited for room to develop, split horses in upper stretch, rallied to the front then held off SATINA late. SATINA had no early speed, advanced two wide on the second turn, swung out five wide into the stretch then closed steadily in the drive. HOT SCRAMBLE stalked the leaders to the second turn, rallied three wide and engaged for the lead at the quarter pole, edged clear to mid stretch but was outrun to the line. CHANEL NUMBER FOUR had no speed, saved ground to the half, shifted three wide on the second turn, rallied when set down and had a mild late bid. TREATHERLIKEALADY settled inside to the half, angled out and rallied four wide to the stretch but flattened out in the drive. LUVTHEDANCE dueled for the lead to the second turn, responded to pressure to the stretch then weakened. JENNIFERS PUB attended the pace three wide to the second turn, tired after six furlongs and was shuffled back into the stretch. LAUNDERING MONEY dueled from between foes to the half then gave out.
