Footnotes

HALO CAT was outrun early, attempted a rally into the turn, was blocked behind horses, had to check and angle in mid turn, rallied when clear into the stretch and finished steadily for the win. MY CAPTAIN pressed the pace to the turn, rallied two wide then was fanned out into the stretch, rallied when sent down for the drive and stayed on gamely once headed late. NEWARK was outrun to the half mile pole, advanced two wide on the turn, came three wide at the quarter pole, got fanned out into the stretch but rallied when clear and stayed on well. EL DORADO SHOOTER had good speed, cleared rivals leaving the half mile pole, remained clear to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. ALLWOOD had no speed, saved ground to the stretch, followed the winner into the stretch but flattened out late. ONEBIGBAG was sent for speed but was outsprinted to the turn, got caught four wide to the stretch and lacked a closing response. TWENTYTHREEJAYBIRD stalked the pace to the turn, was caught outside horses and five wide to the stretch and weakened in the drive. ONEBADSHARK was hustled and attended the pace to the half mile pole, could not keep up with EL DORADO SHOOTER and was four wide to the stretch then tired in the drive.
