YOUNIQUE CAT broke alertly, settled, bid three three wide, inched up, came to even terms in deep stretch, dueled furiously three deep and was up just in time. HONOR YOUR WAGER tracked the leaders two wide to the turn, responded when asked turning for home, shifted out for racing room and rallied boldly on the outside but could not quite get there. COTATI set a pressured pace to the early in the drive, assumed a clear lead before the furlong pole, dug in when approached by the winner but flattened slightly in the final yards. BLACK MALLOU was off a step slow, came five wide through the turn and had little response when asked in the drive. FOX IN THE HOUSE did not reach contention. THUNDERING JUSTICE stumbled at the start, recovered quickly, rushed up to duel with the winner to the turn and gradually gave out.
