KING KELLY was not asked for speed in the early going, commenced his bid once on the turn, circled rivals five wide to the stretch, continued to respond in the drive and was along in time. ROARING TIMES bumped with PUNCH UP at the start and was permitted to settle into stride, advanced four wide and inside the winner on the turn, rallied steadily while splitting foes nearing the wire. SPIRIT TO WIN broke alertly then took back, moved up four wide to the stretch, closed steadily but was outfinished by the top two. MO SLOW MO dueled from the rail throughout and kept to his task in the drive. PUNCH UP bumped with ROARING TIMES at the start and settled, advanced around SIBERIAN COCKTAIL on the turn, entered the lane behind a wall of horses, dropped inside past the furlong pole for a clear path but flattened out. RICHLY RED dueled for the lead from between horses in a four horse spread on the backstretch, remained a factor three wide into the lane but had no response. OFF KILTER settled early, saved ground to rally into the lane then flattened out. STREET CAR dueled between horses into the stretch and gave out. SIBERIAN COCKTAIL dueled between horses and inside STREET CAR to the turn then stopped suddenly.
