Footnotes

A TRUE RUMOR was quick from the gate to duel early, edged clear on the turn, responded in the lane and held driving. BEERTALK was always well placed, raced two wide on the turn then could only close a minor gap in the lane. NOBLE CAVALIER was void of early speed, raced in the two path on the turn then closed willingly. JANS PASKELL stalked two wide, checked in tight quarters into the turn and lacked the needed late response. TRICKY MANDATE stalked four wide to the stretch and gave way. PIMIENTO NEGRO was forwardly placed, steadied while trying to get through tight quarters into the turn, swung four wide but did not rally. BERT'S PAL lacked early speed, was two wide on the turn but never reached contention. IT'S A GOOD DAY settled early, advanced three wide on the turn but could not sustain the rally. CHILI SURPRISE stalked the winner from the rail and gave out. YERPULLINMAHLEG was never a factor. The rider aboard PIMINETO NEGRO lodged an unsuccessful claim of foul against JANS PASKELL.
