QUACKIN had no speed, settled to the half, made a good run while circling four then five wide to the stretch, responded in the drive while drifting inward and got there. PRESTIGE WORLDWIDE stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn, slipped through to take over the lead into the stretch, responded to urging but could not stall the winner. KING BUDRICK had no speed, was unhurried to the second turn, followed the winner five wide to the stretch but could not make a late impact. TEST OF WILL set the pace while racing off the rail on both turns, was collared in upper stretch and finished evenly. SAN SEBASTIAN was four wide to the backstretch, stalked the pace to the second turn, offered his best bid four wide to the stretch but lost his punch in the drive. SPIRIT OF LINDY never far back to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch but failed to rally. ANCIENT MONARCH prompted the pace to the second turn, moved up three deep to loom a threat to the stretch then tired.
