**Footnotes**

R HONOUR AND OBEY was rank to the first turn while racing in traffic, eased off the rail on the backstretch, tracked the leaders to the half, swung out five wide into the stretch then closed with a rush late to win going away. BALLET WAY tracked the pace to the half, rallied four wide to engage for the lead on the second turn, pushed clear to mid stretch then was tiring late and just saved the place. ALASHIR'S STORM had no speed and saved ground, was roused three wide on the second turn then eased out in upper stretch and closed willingly late. KEYNIENTOS also had no speed, raced three wide on the second turn, swung out widest into the stretch and also closed with interest. KING OF BLING had no speed and settled to the half, bid three wide on the second turn then was also gaining in the late stages. HIGH IN THE AIR tracked the pace to the half, raced two wide to the stretch then lacked a closing response. NORTHERN J C prompted the pace to the half, offered his best bid two wide on the second turn, duelled for the lead into the stretch but weakened through the lane. LONDON EXPRESS saved ground to no avail. SEISMIC THUNDER stalked the pace to the half, was three wide and duelled for the lead on the second turn but gave out through the final furlong. WILD SHAMAN set a pressured pace to the second turn, was overtaken into the stretch then stopped.
