PREDICTABLE was pressured on the front end for five furlongs, edged away from FOGGY DEW on the second turn, dug in determinedly in the drive and held. JUST AFTER SUNSET never far back to the second turn, saved ground and offered a bid to mid stretch but was outfinished in the late stages. MARDI'S TOUGH GAME stalked the pace to the second, bid three wide to the stretch then faltered in the final furlong. FOGGY DEW was a pace factor outside the winner to the stretch but faded in mid stretch. COME NEXT MONDAY had no speed, saved ground to the stretch but lacked a closing response. MOBILE QUEEN was four wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn then was asked for speed four deep to the stretch but weakened in the driving. PALISADES DAWN settled mid pack to the second turn, tried to rally two wide to the stretch but gave way through the lane.
