**Footnotes**

WHENTHEWINDBLOWS lagged in the middle of the pack to the final turn, bid four wide, gradually closed the gap and kicked clear in the final yards. SURF TOWN attended the pace from the start, remained close throughout, assumed a brief lead after the furlong pole and was outfinished to the wire. CANDI'S TOAST tracked the leaders from the inside to the final turn, was blocked behind a wall of horses until turning for home, swung out and closed with interest on the outside for the show. IMITATION never far back, saved ground and weakened late. GROUPOFTHEFUTURE raced in the middle of the pack throughout and did not rally. GET OFF THE SUGAR sped to the front soon after the start, set all the pace for three quarters of a mile and gave out in the final furlong. KORCHIE'S SPIRIT showed little. GREY ROVER (GB) trailed to the middle of the stretch and passed a tiring foe. SOPHISTICATEDWAGER raced wide throughout and was never a factor. WHITEOUT STORM showed some speed for three quarters of a mile and came up empty nearing the furlong pole.
