SELIMAN had no early speed, settled for a half, was roused three wide on the second turn but had a wall of horses in front of him, swung out seven wide into the stretch then closed with a strong rally in the final furlong to grab the lead late. FLYING BYE NITE stalked the leaders to the second turn, rallied three wide and dueled to mid stretch, dug in gamely to deepest stretch but could not stall the winner while besting ACADEMY STAGE for the place. ACADEMY STAGE was fanned four wide while tracking the pace on the first turn, remained in the four path and rallied to the leaders on the second turn, dueled to deepest stretch then was outfinished, pulled up lame following the finish and was vanned off. LOFTY M. D. was four wide on the first turn, settled to the half, launched his bid nearing the three eighths but was forced out five wide on the second turn then found his best stride late and was closing. FOR DADDY tracked the pace to the second turn, offered his rally two then three wide to the stretch but lost his punch in the late going. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE also tracked the pace to the second turn, had to wait while boxed in briefly to the five sixteenths, shifted out three wide for room then tried to rally when clear in the stretch but was outfinished late. A NEW LEVEL had no speed, advanced three wide on the second turn but flattened out in mid stretch. PLANCANDU attended the pace to the second turn, responded to urging to the stretch but weakened through the drive. RUNLIKEACHAMPION had no speed and was not a factor. RIO GATO was hustled to duel for the lead for six furlongs but stopped through the lane.
