Footnotes

POP A TOP AGAIN broke alertly and tracked the pace from the rail, got up inside SPEIGHTSTOWNLAWYER at the quarter pole to challenge for the lead, dueled until past mid stretch, then edged clear and held driving. OLD MEMORIES broke slow and lacked early speed, came through inside on the turn to reach contention, eased to the extreme outside leaving the furlong pole and closed steadily. SPEIGHTSTOWNLAWYER set the pace from off the rail, met a bid from the winner at the quarter pole, dueled to mid stretch and slackened. RATHGAR lagged early, was fanned six wide on the turn and finished willingly'. LOBO DEL DESIERTO stalked the pace between horses and weakened. SOUTH FORTY was forwardly placed outside and slackened while four wide on the turn. PURE TRICKIN raced close up three wide and faded. LITTLE CALLTOME showed speed from the outside and gave way while five wide on the turn. HEZA BURNIN FLAME broke slow and was very slow into stride, then quickly rushed up and split horses in the opening quarter and reach the leaders but was all through after a half mile.
