GOOCHIO had good speed and dueled in the opening quarter, inched clear on the turn then dug in determinedly under steady handling to hold. STRONG DEEDS stalked the pace to the turn, was fanned out four deep to the stretch then could not impact the winner while getting up late for the place. METTLER STATION also was stalking to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch, loomed a threat a furlong out but could not sustain the needed bid and just saved the show. SEAFIRE had no speed, angled over early and trailed to the stretch then finished with interest in the final furlong. PRIDE OF WILSHIRE was outrun to the turn, came three wide to the stretch and was making up ground belatedly. BRIANNA MARIE was on the pace to the turn, got outkicked while saving ground to the stretch then weakened. CUSTOM CONTINENTAL chased the leaders to the turn, came two wide to the stretch but failed to offer a late response. WHATEVER WHENEVER had no speed, was five or six wide on the turn and not a threat.
