**Footnotes**

TAKIN IT DEEP was unhurried for a half, responded and closed steadily on the rail to the middle of the second turn, angled out into the stretch, rallied when straightened for the drive and finished strong to win going away. HOOVERGETTHEKEYS bobbled at the start and was also unhurried, bid two wide to the stretch, shifted out into the stretch, responded to pressure but was outrun by the winner. SAN NICOLAS dueled three wide to the half, responded on the second turn, inched away to mid stretch then could not hold. OUT OF MIND (BRZ) had no speed, responded when asked for more on the second turn and closed steadily in the drive. FUTURAL tracked the leaders to the half, bid three deep on the second turn, loomed boldly in upper stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. BOSS EGO was allowed to settle early, began a rally leaving the half, was caught five wide to the stretch and finished with interest late. SLEWSTON was hustled from the gate but was outsprinted, chased the leaders three wide to the second turn then gave way. MISTAKENLY SPECIAL had good early speed, dueled for the lead to the second turn but weakened in the drive. NO NIGHT (GB) was never a factor.
