Footnotes

MAYBE TUESDAY took back early and raced unhurried from off the rail to the second turn, came four wide to the stretch and rallied determinedly and was up in the final stages. FARMER GILES (IRE) was forwardly placed from the rail, eased three wide on the second turn, rallied to the lead at the furlong pole but could not quite last. MILAZZO was unhurried early while four wide to the backstretch, maneuvered to the rail on the second turn and rallied steadily inside. SKATTLE SEATTLE allowed EAST SKY a long lead but kept within striking distance from the inside, eased two wide on the second turn but lacked the needed rally. CURLY BOY settled early three wide, raced two wide on the second turn and came on. TROPICAL HEAT was void of early speed, saved ground on both turns to rally into the stretch but flattened out late. SUMMER SUNSHINE settled early from off the rail then failed to rally while three wide on the second turn. EAST SKY drew off to a long lead on the backstretch then stopped once in the stretch. SAMMARTINO was finished early. PERFECT ENVOY had no speed and was eased.
