BLUEGRASS REWARD was five wide into the first turn, eased closer to the rail to the backstretch, settled to the half, bid two wide into the second turn, swung out four wide for room into the stretch then rallied steadily and wore down GANGSTER OF LOVE in the final yards. GANGSTER OF LOVE was rank in the early stages then remained rank while behind rivals on the first turn, would not settle to the half, finally relaxed to the second turn, again checked in traffic at the five sixteenths, eased out for room nearing the quarter pole, rallied to the front in upper stretch, dug in gamely to deepest stretch but could not stall the winner. TOBIAH'S JOURNEY had good speed and dueled three wide for six furlongs, was collared in upper stretch by the runnerup and weakened in the final sixteenth. COLE IS THE MAN was in traffic on the first turn and checked, settled mid pack to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch while advancing but lost his punch in the stretch. MO PLEASURE stalked the pace to the second turn, was asked for more three wide then got fanned out six wide into the stretch and gave way in the drive. TEA TABLE was four wide to the backstretch, tracked the leaders to the second turn, got forced seven wide into the stretch and came up empty. SILVER BOUNDARY contested the pace while inside to the half, raced two wide on the second turn but stopped after six furlongs.
