FRISCO STAR was used just enough to establish the lead, set all the pace, drew away into the stretch and was not asked for his best. CLASS OF FIFTY had no speed, was put to a drive into the turn, checked behind rivals mid turn then resumed his rally and improved his position. OBJECTIVE was outprinted and chased the winner, came two wide to the stretch but could not threaten and relinquished second. UH HIPPIE also chased the pace to the turn, came three wide to the stretch but weakened in the drive. DR. EINSTEIN was outrun to the turn, saved ground to the stretch but a late response. IEKA MINER was allowed to settle early, raced three wide into the turn then checked away from TEN IN FRONT mid turn and lacked a rally. FROM ABOVE was hustled early but was outprinted, chased two wide to the stretch then gave way. CAPRICIOUS ONE was always outrun. TEN IN FRONT had brief speed but was outprinted, raced four wide on the turn but tired after a half and stopped in the drive.
