CORAZON DE LEO broke alertly then was outsprinted to the turn, got put to a drive mid turn while three wide, responded in the stretch then zipped away in the final sixteenth. LIFE'S A THRILL showed good speed, dueled outside of FREE THE WORLD to the turn, was caught four wide to the stretch, battled to mid stretch then was no match for the winner in the final sixteenth but grabbed second. FREE THE WORLD contested the pace inside of LIFE'S A THRILL, was three wide on the turn, dueled to mid stretch then was outfinished by the winner and missed the place. CAMPEENYA had no speed, raced in the two path to the stretch but failed to rally in the lane. LOOK AT MADDIE GO also had no speed, got fanned four wide while attempting to rally outside the winner on the turn but was not a threat in the drive. BERTIE broke a bit slow then was outsprinted, chased the leaders to the turn but stopped in the stretch.
