FIRE BREAK stalked the pace from the inside early under strong restraint, steadied midway down the backstretch off the leaders then was permitted to race up inside IDLE CHATTER at the half mile pole and engage for the lead, dueled into the stretch, took command and edged clear briefly then was all out to last. STORMY SURGE tracked the leaders from just off the rail throughout, responded leaving the furlong pole and was getting to the winner late. MIAMI HOUSE lagged early from off the rail, dropped inside on the second turn, rallied into the stretch to loom a bold factor at the furlong pole then lost some of his punch. CAPTAIN ROY took back early and was hard held while three wide to the backstretch, was floated five wide into the stretch and finished steadily. ROLL THE POINT dueled outside IDLE CHATTER to the second turn and slackened. OUR MAN LUKE raced close up from the rail early, raced two wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. IDLE CHATTER dueled from just off the rail into the stretch and weakened.
