Footnotes

DALLY MAY tracked the leaders nicely from the rail to the second turn, advanced inside then swung out for room into the stretch, rallied when roused and forged to the lead late then drove clear. HOLIDAY EVENT never far back to the half, bid two then three wide to the stretch, responded through the final furlong but could not impact the winner while second best. ICY ROUTE stalked the pace three wide to the half, came three wide to the stretch, remained a factor to mid stretch then finished evenly. BADGETT AT NIGHT had no speed, got over to the rail and saved ground, made a run inside on the second turn then finished steadily late while right on the fence. GINGER HOFFA tried to get out into the first turn and was under restraint, settled to the half, bid two wide to the stretch then came on late and finished on even terms with LEREYEV. The latter was caught four wide to the backstretch, stalked the leaders to the second turn, fell back to the stretch, was caught widest into the stretch and finished well late. TIGER AGAIN prompted the pace two wide to the second turn, responded to get to terms with the leader to mid stretch then could not sustain the needed response. EMPRESS ANNA (IRE) had the best speed, set all the pace under pressure to the second turn, responded to mid stretch but gave way in the final furlong. ROAD TO MONEY was caught four wide to the

backstretch while well back, got to the rail and saved ground to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. DON PESO was outrun throughout and stopped on the second turn.
