TANKER YANKER tracked the leaders to the turn, offered a bid three wide into the turn then was fanned five wide to the stretch but rallied smartly in the final furlong and was pulling away late. DREAM DE JUSTICE contested the pace to the turn, was off the rail to the stretch, dug in and battled to mid stretch then was outrun by the winner but bested GOLD STAR and held off RUFANO'S ROBERTO late for second. RUFARO'S ROBERTO also tracked the pace to the turn, raced off the rail to the stretch then shifted out in mid stretch and finished well in the late stages to just miss second. GOLD STAR attended the pace outside of the runnerup, was three wide and battled to take a short lead to mid stretch then was also outfinished by the winner and gave up second then third in the very late stages. SKIING CHUMAREE chased the pace to the turn, was two wide to the stretch but failed to rally when asked. PERFECT KIVA also chased the pace while saving ground but came up empty in the drive. KLASSY CITIZEN attended the pace outside rivals to the turn, was caught four wide to the stretch then gave way. ONLY TOP MONEY had no speed and was not a factor. CORRIE SONG broke in a tangle, was never a factor then pulled up lame following the finish and was vanned off. OH ME OH MY showed little.
