Footnotes

THORO GALAXY broke inward but was quickly corrected and pressed the pace early, challenged two wide on the turn, drew clear in the upper stretch and held driving. WENTZVILLE MAN was permitted to settle early, advanced three wide on the turn and finished steadily. LOOKINGFORLOVE was never too far back, raced outside HI AND GOODBYE on the turn and went evenly through the drive. SURF CITY BRAT set the pace from the rail and weakened once in the stretch. GIANT STEPS lacked good early speed, raced three wide on the turn but never reached serious contention. FREE LOVIN' broke alertly but fell back quickly, raced four wide on the turn and did not rally. HI AND GOODBYE was squeezed off at the start and steadied, recovered to race up inside to reach contention in the opening quarter, remained a factor to the stretch then faded. INDY RIVER broke slow and was never a factor while two wide on the turn. BOOGIE BUTT raced in mid pack early but came up empty entering the lane in the three path.
