**Footnotes**

LADY DEPUTY was never far back to the second turn, rallied three wide then was floated four or five wide into the stretch, responded when set down for the drive and won under steady urging. BEAR MARKET set the pace while off the rail to the second turn, drifted out to the four path into the stretch, resisted the winner to deep stretch then was outfinished. TEQUILA TONIGHT was settled for a half mile, came two wide into the second turn, eased four wide into the stretch then was gaining ground belatedly. BLUE MOON HIGH was unhurried to the half, got fanned six wide while rallying into the stretch and finished willingly. LADY LOHR tracked the leaders to the second turn, raced three wide to the stretch but could not muster the needed late response. ARRIVEDERCI CARO had no speed and settled to the half, tried to rally from the three path on the second turn but was not a threat in the drive. JANS DYNASTY lagged to the second turn and did not reach contention. PRINCESS LUCAY was under a snug hold to the half mile pole, got fanned five wide on the second turn and gave way in the lane. SCENT OF CHRISM prompted the pace for six furlongs then gave out. SHESASOLDIER also was a pace presser to the second turn but stopped suddenly after six furlongs.
