TUSHER MTN MAN was well placed behind the leader two wide to the middle of the turn, rallied when roused in the stretch and closed steadily to take over leaving the furlong grounds and win going away. RINO SONG set all the pace from the rail to the stretch, was clear to mid stretch but tired and could not stall the winner while best of the rest. KERN RIVER tracked the pace to the turn, tried to rally three deep to the stretch but failed to make an impact. LOUIS WHO had no speed, got fanned four wide on the turn then could only improve his position in the lane. APRESENTFROMYOLY chased the pace to the turn, was two wide to the stretch and failed to rally. RATA TAT KAT tracked the pace early, was caught out four wide to the stretch and also lacked a late response. BUCKSHOT BOB chased the pace from the rail to the stretch then gave way. G R HEART had no speed and was not a factor. SENIOR RAPIDO saved ground to no avail. STORM DOCTOR hesitated and broke slow then was never prominent in a dull debut.
