NORMANDY PRINCESS stalked the leader from the start, responded when asked when turning for home and kicked clear late. SWEET KENDALL JO pulled to the front soon after the start, set all the pace to the furlong pole but could not hold off the fast closing winner. WILD REFLECTION never far back, saved ground through the turn and showed late interest to just miss the place. BADGETT'S MANGO leapt from the gate, raced into contention through the turn, was forced to alter his course when squeezed between the stumbling rival and the rail then gamely continued when clear. ALMOND BLOSSOM was slow to find his stride, lagged to the stretch and could not rally. CAHILL ROYALTY tracked the leader while racing three wide through the turn, stumbled badly after straightening into the stretch when attempting to jump a ruffled area of the course and lost his rider.
