IRENES JACKPOT was outsprinted early, bid two then three wide to the stretch, rallied to get to terms with the runnerup in mid stretch then battled tooth and nail with that one through the final furlong and won by a whisker. I CEE'S A TIGER broke alertly but was outsprinted, chased the leaders to the turn, bid four wide then was fanned out six deep into the stretch, rallied to get to terms for the lead in mid stretch, fought gamely to the line and just was nipped. MISS NIKKI J chased the pace to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch, shifted out for room in upper stretch, was outkicked by the top two but was in a battle of her own for third and got the better of TROPHY CATCH in the last stride. TROPHY CATCH had no speed, saved ground on the turn, shifted out in upper stretch, rallied to get to terms with MISS NIKKI J in mid stretch and did not impact the top two but was game to the line and just missed the show. REDSEASALT was on the pace outside of I'LL BE SEEING YOU to the stretch, inched away from that one briefly before being engaged by the top two

finishers a furlong out and weakened. PEARLOFTHEORIENT had no speed, was five or six wide throughout and never a threat. I'LL BE SEEING YOU had speed from the rail, dueled inside to the stretch then gave out. STORM ALLIE stalked the pace three or four wide to the stretch then stopped.
