HILL OF TARA was well placed in the early stages, permitted the runnerup to race clear on the backstretch, edged closer into the second turn, rallied two wide to get to terms in mid stretch then battled gamely to prevail. TRIBAL DELIGHT had good speed then sped away from rivals once on the backstretch, was rated when clear which allowed the others to close the gap, dueled the winner on the second turn, dug in determinedly but was bested in the final stages. SILVERADA was unhurried to the half, bid three wide on the second turn, had the rider drop his whip at the three sixteenths,then finished steadily through the stretch. BALENTINA was well placed inside to the second turn, followed the runnerup into the stretch then could not muster the needed late response. DOVER CROSSING had no speed, settled early, bid inside on the second turn but went evenly through the drive. HEY MARIA was four wide early and settled, got fanned out five wide while rallying on the second turn then lost her punch in the stretch. JENNY'S FIRST GEAR chased the pace early, was three then four wide while trying to rally on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. D'PRINCESS was fractious right when the latch was sprung and broke in the air then was never prominent.
