**Footnotes**

SHELLINGITOUT raced up between horses in the opening quarter to pressure the pace, forged to the front after a half mile, drew clear in the upper stretch and extended her advantage while being kept to her task. TANNINGATTHEBEACH was permitted to settle just off the dueling leaders, tried to rally outside on the turn, was fanned six wide into the lane and came on for the place without being a serious factor. SKIPPIN' THE STORM attended the pace outside a four horse spread on the backstretch, drifted to the five path entering the lane and did not respond. KAWANI RUN dueled from the inside to the head of the lane and weakened. MIGHTY MATTY was never a factor. REGENT FAN dueled between horses from the three path in the opening half mile but had nothing left for the drive.
