### Footnotes

HIRSCHY was slow into stride, commenced his bid between horses and three wide on the turn, rallied determinedly outside OUTLOOK in the lane and bested that rival late. OUTLOOK settled early but was within easy striking distance, slipped back slightly on the turn two wide but closed stoutly in the lane. TIME FOR ANGIE lagged early, raced four wide on the turn and finished steadily. LUCK LASTS set the pace from the inside until past the furlong pole but slackened. TUPELO CUSH pressed the pace two wide into the stretch but lacked a closing response. CAJUN HIPPIE settled early, saved ground and gave way once on the turn.
