LUCKARACK tracked the dueling leaders from the outset, was boxed behind those rivals and inside KINGSFORD DRIVE to the quarter pole, quickly swung outside KINGSFORD DRIVE to overtake him near the furlong pole and drew clear driving. KING COLA raced unhurried early, commenced his bid while angling four wide on the turn and finished steadily but could not reach the winner. KINGSFORD DRIVE stalked the pace from the outset, moved up three wide nearing the quarter pole to take command into the stretch but flattened out in the drive. OVER THE BUDGET was void of early speed, raced off the rail on the turn and came on without being a serious factor. RIVER'S CHAPEL duelled outside AMMUNITION to mid turn, led briefly at the quarter pole but slackened in the lane. BANDITONTHELOOSE was never a factor. AMMUNITION duelled from the rail to the turn and stopped.
