SOURDOUGH SAM had no speed, saved ground to mid turn, shifted two wide into the stretch then kicked into gear in upper stretch, split rivals and shot to the front then held under steady urging. ONE ROYAL STAR was outsprinted to the turn, bid two wide to the stretch then finished gamely to save the place. FRUMIOUS chased the leaders to the turn, was three wide to the stretch, responded to mid stretch then was outfinished in the late stages. OUR SHORTY tracked the pace early, got fanned four wide to the stretch then finished willingly through the final furlong. BARREL KNOT was outsprinted to the turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch then made steady progress in the last eighth. WIND SHIFTER tracked the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch but weakened through the final furlong. BUCK'S BRO had no speed and was eased outside rivals on the backstretch, raced four wide on the turn then failed to threaten in the lane. WILLYCAN was shuffled back to last nearing the turn, raced two wide to the stretch but also was not a threat. C'MON MARQUIS pressed the pace two wide to the stretch but gave out in mid stretch. J. P.'S DREAMS set the early pace, widened the advantage on the turn but stopped in mid stretch.
