WATCH YOUR MONEY was very fractious at the gate, got loose and ran off for a sixteenth of a mile, but broke alertly then was taken back, began to advance once on the backstretch from the outside, raced four wide to the stretch and rallied steadily to get up in the final strides. CREEK VALLEY stalked the pace two wide from the outset, took command two wide in the upper stretch but could not quite hold. DAILY SUDS raced unhurried from the rail early, moved up three wide on the second turn and finished willingly but too late. BEST PLAN was permitted to settle early, rallied three wide into the lane but flattened out late. YOU'RE NO GOOD was close up early from the rail early but fell back on the backstretch, raced two wide on the second turn and came on without being a factor. SUPPLY N DEMAND set the pace from the inside to the head of the lane and came up empty. TRADE MASTER raced up into the first turn and made his way to the rail to track the leaders for six furlongs and faded. BOLD MEETING was void of early speed, moved up briefly from the outside on the backstretch but had little left while five wide on the second turn. FORREST VIEW saved ground to no avail. DOUG'S BOY settled in mid pack but raced five wide on the second turn and faded.
