VONDALE pressed the early pace, duelled with CATCHDAGENT throughout and prevailed in deep stretch. CATCHDAGENT pressed the early pace, duelled with the winner throughout and was outfinished in the late stages. DANDY PLEASURE tracked the leaders, raced three wide into the turn, angled in into the stretch and was no match for top two finishers. TANGLED TOUCH pressed the early pace, swung three wide into the turn and steadily faltered from the eighth pole. WAY NO raced mid pack early while saving ground and had no punch in the drive. NANA'S LITTLE FOX offered no speed while saving ground and never was a threat. BABABING raced wide throughout and never offered a rally. M. J.'S SECRET trailed early, while saving ground and never was a factor. MUSICAL PRIDE lagged early and never offered a rally. MOMA MARY AL stalked the early pacesetters and faltered in the stretch.
