LUCKY JOHN drew quickly clear racing off the inside, was never challenged and much the best. ROANIE'S STAR was unhurried early saving ground, angled three wide to place a bid, got up for the place but was no threat to the winner. HENNESSY N GIN broke sharply then chased the early leader four wide, sustained a bid near the eighth pole then flattened but held the show. SHE'S TRUE CLASS was unhurried early, went five wide and lacked a late effort. BANGOR was off slow early and sustained a mild bid mid track. MR ERIC raced mid pack off the inside, angled out six wide and lacked a rally. CHUECO'S SONG was forwardly placed early saving ground then gave way. BLUE JACKET SAILOR was outrun early racing three wide, angled seven wide in the stretch and faded. JOHN PEARL raced wide trailing the field and was not a factor.
