Footnotes

TRUSTEE TOM stalked the early leader from the outside, sustained a bid, to surge clear, was full of run late and opened up. BIG KISS was off slow early, gained steadily, went between foes at the eight pole and gained the place late. A. J. DA SKIPPER was forwardly placed early, went four wide nearing the quarter pole and placed a mild bid. MAKING PAPA PROUD raced mid pack, sustained a brief bid five wide then weakened. MY OTHER MEMO was unhurried early, the rider lost his whip near the quarter pole, angled out five wide near the eight pole and lacked a rally. GET UP TAYLOR set the early pace drawing clear while saving ground and was finished after a half. GOLDEN CHAIN was allowed to settle early saving ground and lacked a bid. IRON JUSTICE was off slow, went five wide trailing the field and was not a threat.
