Footnotes

BROADWAY BOY prompted the early pace four wide, vied to gain the lead drawing clear, was challenged in deep stretch, dug in the final strides and held gamely. ACTIONABLE OFFENSE was unhurried early racing three wide, swung out five wide to sustain a bid nearing the quarter pole, was on even terms with BROADWAY BOY fought hard but missed in the final yards. FLAME BROILED was allowed to settle early along the inside, rallied at the top of the stretch, drifted out while showing some interest late. JACK CARTER was outrun early, went six wide and showed some effort late. VAMANOS AMIGO was forwardly placed early, went five wide and lacked a rally. STORM HARVEST was void of early speed, raced mid track late and passed tiring foes. MANNAK set the early pace along the rail and was finished after a half. MY RIKELY raced mid pack saving ground then faded. DUBBER forced the early pace from the outside then retreated steadily. The rider of ACTIONABLE OFFENSE claimed interference against the rider of BROADWAY BOY in deep stretch and after reviewing the films the Stewards determined there would be no change.
