Footnotes

DESERT GULCH was allowed to settle early, angled out nearing the second turn, went six wide into the stretch, closed well and kicked clear. DISAPPEARING FLY was within striking distance early, rallied three wide into the second turn, contested the pacesetter at the eighth pole then flattened and was outfinished. IRISH TITO pressed the early pace three wide, gained a short lead down the backstretch, was challenged in the second turn then yielded in the lane but held the show. GOOD AND YOU was well back early, began to close the gap angling three wide in the second turn then showed some interest late in the lane. KEY TO THE BAND was unhurried early, sustained a brief bid into the second turn then came up empty in the drive. DOMS TRICK showed some brief speed racing off the rail then faded. GOLDEN M P was outrun and not a factor.
