Footnotes

DRY GOLD pressed the pace, two wide, then rallied down the lane for a driving finish. DEPUTRESS was near the back, on the rail and made a steady gain to get up for second. A GHOST BY CHOICE stalked the pace, three wide and faltered late. GONE ALREADY was mid field, three wide with mild late interest. RED TAPPER trailed the field, two wide and passed tiring rivals. HAMONCITO made the lead, and faded at the three eighths pole. BERNARDO STAR was in contention early on the inside and was through after the half. RUNNING HOLLYWOOD was near the front, four wide and through early.
