BECKY'S PRIDE stalked the early leaders four wide, began to rally into the second turn, gained a short lead at the eight pole and held sway. SUPER SEAMAN broke inward at the break to get away slowly, sustained a bid four wide into the stretch and closed well. GO BLAKERS GO set the early pace along the rail, dueled down the backstretch then weakened in the second turn but held the show. DESERT BURN pressed the early pace from the outside, dueled briefly down the backstretch then tired and gave way. CHAPELBELLEGIRL was outrun early racing off the rail and improved her position in the stretch. GOLLYS GUY was wide early and lacked a closing response. BATTLE CREEK HIWAY was pinched back at the break, recovered well to be within striking then retreated after a half.
